**Course I: Saturday, 21st November
Beginner's Course in „Laryngeal Manipulation“**

The application of physical therapy in the management of voice disorders. Rationale, anatomy and physiology of voice production, laryngeal examination using the Lieberman protocol. The course is aimed at SLT, ENT laryngologists, physiotherapists, other therapists who use manual techniques.

**Course II: Sunday, 22nd November
Advanced Course in „Laryngeal Manipulation“**

Summary of anatomy and physiology, safety when applying Laryngeal Manipulation
Specific techniques: head-neck position, jaw, TMJ function, suprahyoid muscles, middle constrictor, thyrohyoid mechanism, crico-thyroid joint articulation, inferior and strap muscles, breathing apparatus. The techniques will be demonstrated, then practised by participants. If time allows, Laryngeal Manipulation under transnasal endoscopy will be shown and some psychological aspects of voice problems will be discussed. The course is aimed at practitioners who have attended a previous course on Laryngeal Manipulation who developed the palpation experience to examine laryngeal structures.
