# LARYNGEAL MANIPULATION AND OSTEOPATHY

COURSE I & II

**13–14 February 2016, Jacob Lieberman, D.O.**

## **Course I for Beginners: Saturday, February 13**

Contents: The application of physical therapy in the management of voice disorders. Rationale, anatomy and physiology of voice production, laryngeal examination using the Lieberman protocol. The course is aimed at SLT, ENT laryngologists, physiotherapists, other therapists who use manual techniques.

## **Course II for Experienced Participants: Sunday, February 14**

Contents: Summary of anatomy and physiology, safety when applying Laryngeal Manipulation. Specific techniques: head-neck position, jaw, TMJ function, suprahyoid muscles, middle constrictor, thyrohyoid mechanism, crico-thyroid joint articulation, inferior and strap muscles, breathing apparatus. The techniques will be demonstrated, then practiced by participants. Some psychological aspects of voice problems will be discussed. The course is aimed at practitioners who have attended a previous course on Laryngeal Manipulation and who developed experience in palpation to examine laryngeal structures.
